Consultation Charges

Private Health Services Regulatory Council (PHSRC) has received several complaints through different channels including direct communication from customers, community action groups, Consumer Affairs Authority and Presidential Secretariat regarding high consultation fees and exorbitant charges imposed by Private Medical Centers.

After much deliberations including obtaining views and observations from different stakeholders and careful evaluation of the situation, PHSRC at its meeting held on 08/08/2014 decided to request all Private Medical Centers to comply with following with regards to consultation charges for the benefit of general public.

You are hereby requested to adhere to prevailing consultation charge of SLR 250 to SLR 2,000 per consultation by a Consultant/Specialist. No Private Medical Centre is expected to charge more than SLR. 2,000 per consultation until further notice. Every Medical Centre should display the prevailing consultation charges to be easily viewed by the public and if unable or difficult to comply in print mode, could do so electronically.

Your kind cooperation in this regard is greatly appreciated.
